Minutes of the IUGG Joint Tsunami Commission Business Meeting Prague, Czech Republic, June 29, 2015

- 1. Adoption of the agenda
 - VT calls for objections/changes to agenda none. Agenda adopted
- 2. Activity Reports of Commission
 - a. Meetings
 - VT says meetings & publication important goals of JTC. Thanks AY & UK for organising Gojek meeting.
 - Current IUGG largest ever: 9 oral sessions with 54 presentations and a poster session with 40 posters.
 - VT reports IOC meetings have been well reported to JTC, important connection. 50th PTWC anniversary symposium in Hawaii very successful, proceedings open for anyone to submit.
 - AR announces 2019 IUGG assembly to be in Canada.
 - b. Publications associated with JTC activity:
 - AR 2013 proceedings "beautiful", thanks LK and PD.
 - Natural Hazards, Nat Haz/Springer book on Met. Tsunamis. Nat Haz
 - Tsunamis in the Pacific Ocean 2011-2012
 - Tsunami Science: 10 years after the IOT
 - \circ V1: 22 papers -published, VII 18: papers t.b.s.
 - New Proc. needed for IUGG 2015, Eds. E Geist, H Fritz, A. Rabinovich, calls for one more
 - New series Lec. Notes. Geosystems Math Comp. suggested volume on landslide-generated tsunamis
 - ID suggests additional publication following EGU tsunami session. AR, VT agree, the more the better
 - VT suggests PAGEOPH for IUGG 2015 no votes against, accepted.
 - YT 'volunteered' as additional editor
 - VT thanks AR for editing role

c. Other

- KS announces IOC/TOWS meeting on Max EQ size and tsunami earthquakes (at IUGG Prague).
- KS points out IASPEI and IAPSO meetings in Aug-Sept 2017, best to avoid for 2017 ITS
- GP: Announces Int'l Tsunami Workshop Crete, Oct 2015
- AY announces ICEE 2016 (in Turkey?)
- 3. Activity Reports of Working Groups
 - a. VT suggests reducing number of WGs
 - b. WG for 2004 measurement data (Guisakov, Fujima)

- GS suggests merge WGs on measurement data, instrumental data, historical data standards, and data standards, to one group. EO seconds
- PD meteotsunamis should be in a separate catalog
- AR agrees to merged WG, GS & PD should chair. Tsunamis of unknown origin put in meteotsunamis(?), suggests someone join WG
- EO meteotsunami problematic not only for historical events, but modern ones as well.
- VT moves new WG to be "Tsunami Data Standards' passed.
- KS if new WG includes paleotsunamis, it need a member with paleotsunami expertise
- c. WG for 2004 instrumental data (Rabinovich)
- d. WG on terminology (Power, Dengler, Greenslade)
 - WP has been dormant what to do: close, merge with data standards?
 - VT suggest move to ITIC
 - EO nominates CS for WG
 - LK there will always be terms no one agrees on, publish anyway, last out in 2013 with 2015 addendum.
 - DG suggests WG terminology remains, add LK.
- e. WG for post-tsunami survey field guide (Dominey-Howes)
 - LD field guide done, on line, no major tsunami yet. Suggests close WG because job is done. Approved.
- f. WG on historical tsunami data standards (Gusiakov, Dunbar, Tsuji)
- g. New WG on tsunami data standards (AR, Mungov)
- h. WG on science-based tsunami warning (ST)
 - EO asks what are non-scientific TWS?
 - ST Motivation: Use Science to identify gaps & ways to fill them. Reports on various aspects of current TWSs. Proposes that a report be written, invites contributors, to be submitted to next ITS. VT 2nds, suggests submit to IUGG 2015 proc. Report voted.
 - TS Should consider new approaches such as GPS
- i. WG on tsunami scenarios (Dimitri Nicolsky)
 - VT presents report from DN, suggests WG continue
- j. WG on tsunami magnitude (Titov)
 - VT no meetings, WG's work is proceeding. Suggests WG continue.
 - CS suggests EO join, EO agrees.
 - VT suggests a report be produced for next ITS. Voted.
- 4. New Working Groups?
 - a. VT Suggests a GNSS WG.
 - b. KS announces IUGG resolution on real time GNSS augmentation of TWS.
 - c. TS comments GNSS data not shared. Claims US data already available.
 - d. EO Objects to resolution's focus on Pacific region, questions whether GNSS method focusses on megathrust sources only.
 - e. VT can form WG and/or pass resolution, make recommendations
 - f. LK doesn't understand why IUGG deals with operational matters

- g. VT suggests to form WG on assessing GNSS capability
- h. KS needs to have connection with GNSS suggests TS
- i. TS points out that resolution is mostly aimed at freeing data.
- j. VT moves to form WG, with TS as liaison to IAG. HT, TS, VT as member. VT chosen to head.
- 5. Nomination of new members
 - a. FI announces death of Koji Fujima. VT suggests moment of silence.
 - b. CH-A announces A. Mercado no longer to serve as member
 - c. VT Caribbean liaison to shift to CH-A
 - d. EO Puerto Rico part of US? CH-A Yes.
 - e. VT nominates KSt as new US member. EO seconds.
 - f. FI nominates AS as new Thailand member. VT seconds
 - g. RA nominates IV as new Croatia member,
 - h. KS nominates HT as new member from Japan. Seconded.
 - i. AR nominates MH.
 - j. LD nominates ES as new US member. Seconded.
 - k. CH-A nominates FS as new member from France.
 - l. All new members voted.
- 6. TC officers election
 - a. KS current officers to continue. Voted.
- 7. Potential venue(s) for 2017 meeting
 - a. CH-A proposes Puerto Rico as ITS 2017 venue
 - b. AM proposes Bali
 - c. CS points out that Oct is bad for academics, other dates possible? CH-A PR OK for June, MH Indonesia flexible
 - d. LD Asks relative costs; VT thinks they are comparable
 - e. VT calls for vote: 15 for PR, 17 for Bali. Bali chosen as venue for Next ITS.
